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ORDER:

The Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India have launched the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) with an objective to provide basic services (e.g. water supply, sewerage, urban transport) to households and build amenities in cities that will directly improve the quality of life, especially the poor and the disadvantaged which is identified by the Government of India as a National Priority. The Mission guidelines of the AMRUT envisaged that the purpose of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) is to (i) ensure that every household has access to a tap with assured supply of water and a sewerage connection; (ii) increase the amenity value of cities by developing greenery and well maintained open spaces (e.g. parks); and (iii) reduce pollution by switching to public transport or constructing facilities for non-motorized transport (eg. walking and cycling). All these outcomes are valued by citizens particularly women, and indicates and standards have been prescribed by the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) in the form of Service Level Benchmarks (SLBs)

2. The Apex Committee of AMRUT at the National Level have in its meeting held on 21.10.2015 in the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India, New Delhi approved the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of 2015-16 for the 30 AMRUT ULBs with an estimated project cost of Rs.662.86 Crore being Central Share Rs.300.41 Crore for the 2015-16 project period.

3. The Mission Directorate, AMRUT at State Level i.e Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation, Hyderabad vide reference 8th read above has stated that State Level High Powered Steering Committee headed by the Chief Secretary in its meeting held on 18.03.2016 has approved the Detailed Project Reports of the 30 AMRUT ULBs which the State Level Technical Committee had scrutinized and recommended for total project cost of Rs.804.46 Crore for the project period 2015-16. The projects cost of 804.46 Crore is 151.58 Crore more than that of the Projects cost approved by the APEX Committee of the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India. This is reported that the increase of 151.58 Crore is resulted in due to inclusion of in-admissible components such as Operation and Maintenance, VAT, Cess, Seignarage & other Contingencies etc in the Projects cost and is meant for 5 years Project Period. The State Level High Powered Steering Committee has recommended that the cost of the inadmissible components is to be met by the respective AMRUT ULB from its own funds in addition to its share under the admissible components of the Scheme. And further recommended that ULBs have to deposit their share with the Mission Directorate AMRUT, AP, Hyderabad who inturn

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releases the same to the concerned PAOs where the projects are implemented through the Public Health and Engineering Department under the AMRUT Scheme. The Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Urban Finance and Infrastructure Corporation, Hyderabad has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for the total project cost of Rs. 804.46 Crore (Rupees Eight Hundred Four Crore Forty Six Lakh Only) of the 30 AMRUT Urban Local Bodies for the year 2015-16 with the following funding pattern as recommended by the State Level High Powered Steering Committee:

• Gol Share	- Rs.295.46Cr.
• GoAP Share	- Rs.130.56Cr.
• ULB share including inadmissible cost	- Rs.378.44Cr.
Total Projects cost:	-Rs.804.46 Cr.

4. Government after careful examination of the matter hereby accord administrative sanction for the total Projects cost of Rs.804.46 Crore (Rupees Eight Hundred Four Crore and Forty Six Lakh Only) of the 30 AMRUT Urban Local Bodies for the project period 2015-16 and sharing of the project cost among the Government of India, State Government and the 30 AMRUT ULBs shall be as indicated in the table under para (3) supra. The additional cost of Rs. 151.58 Crore towards in- admissible components indicated above shall be borne by the respective AMRUT ULB from its own funds in addition to meeting its share under admissible components of the Scheme. Government also orders that in the cases where projects are implemented by the Public Health and Engineering Department under the AMRUT Scheme, the respective ULB shall deposit its share with the Mission Directorate, AMRUT who inturn shall release the same to the concerned PAOs of the AMRUT ULBs so as to ensure timely releases to the Project Implementing Agencies and execution of the Projects.

5. The Mission Directorate, AMRUT, the Director of Municipal Administration, A.P., Hyderabad, and the Chief Engineer (Public Health) shall take necessary action accordingly. They shall ensure that the guidelines of the AMRUT Scheme stipulated by the Government of India, and State Government are followed scrupulously. They are also requested to obtain necessary orders from the State/Gol where ever necessary.

6. The Commissioners of the 30 AMRUT ULBs shall submit monthly financial and physical progress reports on achieving the targets set forth in the SAAP, and the Detailed Project Reports approved above, to the Mission Directorate, AMRUT, the Director of Municipal Administration, A.P., Hyderabad, and the Chief Engineer (Public Health) who will submit consolidated progress reports to the Government from time to time. They are requested to take all necessary steps towards proper and effective implementation of the Scheme on Mission mode.
