It is noticed by the under signed that Estimates, DPRs, Tender evaluations, Deviation statements of various works taken up in urban local bodies are sent to this office directly for approvals without scrutiny of concerned EE(PH) and SE(PH) which is highly irregular procedure. Hence all the Commissioners of Urban Local bodies (where there is no Municipal Engineer (Grade-1) / SE posts in that ULB) are requested to process the work files through the concerned Executive Engineer (PH) and Superintending Engineer (PH) only, otherwise they will be returned.

In this connection all the Superintending Engineers, Executive Engineers of Public Health Engineering Department and the Urban Local Bodies are directed to inspect the site and verify the proposals as per the site conditions, lead statements, data, soil reports, traffic surveys and designs before submitting the same to this office. All the proposals of DPRs shall also be examined in detail with respect to site conditions and verify the proposals with technical and economical aspect.

All Superintending Engineers, Executive Engineers of Public Health Engineering Department and the Urban Local Bodies are directed to adhere to

the above instructions and any deviation observed in this regard will be viewed seriously. If any lapses are observed in this regard personal responsibility will be fixed against the officers who are responsible for the lapses.

Further all the Executive Engineers (PH) and Superintending Engineers (PH) are requested to regularly monitor the water supply in the ULBs under their jurisdiction for ensuring both quality and quantity of water supply to the urban citizens during the ensuing summer season and also to report any deficiency in advance to this office.

All Municipal Commissioners and Engineers are requested to closely monitor all the works taken up in ULBs with frequent inspections and surprise checks for ensuring quality and timely completion.

This is MOST URGENT.
